






The gate to a market of 500 million people


- Three main markets within short reach: Western EU, Eastern EU, Africa and Middle East










Life sciences and nanotechnology

Stones & marbles

Piemonte material was used in the construction of: the **Duomo of Milan**, the Royal Palace of Bangkok, the base of the Statue of Liberty and of the Christopher Columbus monument in New York, the subway stations of Brussels, Singapore and Tokyo, the airports of Milan Malpensa, Frankfurt and Amsterdam.

- Stones are used for: private and industrial construction (floors and wall cladding for interior and exterior work, treads, elevations, skirting boards, thresholds, windowsills, window frames, portals, frames, balconies, mantelpieces and columns); urban design (street paving, benches, fountains and flower boxes); home furnishing (fireplaces, table tops, kitchen and bathroom surfaces)
- 280 enterprises: 110 excavation companies, 160 processing companies, 10 manufacturers of stone-processing machinery
- 1,200 employees
- 54 quarries providing: serizzo gneiss, beola gneiss, granite
- Export: 18 million € per year.
